What is PDF?

- Portable Document Format (PDF), is a file format developed by Adobe in 1993 to present documents.
- Initially they were not editable without buying an expensive license from Adobe, now you can add text and signatures to PDF files within the Adobe reader using the 'fill and sign' tool
- If you want to send someone a document that you don't want them to be able to edit, you can create your own PDFs from Open Office, Word and many other apps using the Print dialogue and Microsoft Print to PDF (or Mac save as PDF).

 PDF's can be split and merged using the free tool PDFSAM from https://pdfsam.org/
